

### Questions about Camp?

### What are accommodations like?

Boys and girls will have separate accommodations in cabins or rooms in a main lodge. There will be 2 leaders for each cabin/room.

#### My child/youth has food restrictions, can this be managed?

We will do our best to accommodate food restrictions or allergies if we are aware of them at the time of application. We cannot guarantee halal, but will ensure no pork is served. Vegetarian options are available.

### Who will be running the camp?

Camp Directors are Jay and Laura Callaghan, they work with African Inland Mission. Jay is a teacher, Laura is a pediatric nurse practitioner. They have 5 children, live in Nova Scotia and have lived in Africa for 6 years. They love finding ways to support Africans in Canada.

#### What if I don't have all the camping supplies?

If you don't have all the supplies, don't worry. Let us know what you need and we will help you find the items your child will need for camp.

### My Child attended CAMP SOAR last year, can they apply again?

Yes! We are looking forward to seeing some of the children/youth campers return from previous year's camp! Consider bringing a friend. There are also opportunities for "Leaders in training spots" for those >14yrs.

#### When will I know if my child has been accepted to CAMP SOAR?

Once we receive the application we will review it, if child/youth accepted to the camp they will be notified by post mail and email with further important details (time/location for pick up and drop off). Camp Fee is due on arrival to camp. Bus transportation from Halifax is available

What about COVID? - Camp SOAR will comply with COVID guidance for camps as outlined by the Province. If phases change, and camp can not run, we will notify campers as soon as possible.


