Some boxes of KN95 masks were ordered from Costco online, only to have the order cancelled 3 days later. Mrs. Campbell was able to get some masks from Lawton's on Gladstone (5/\$4.99) but were limited one package/customer. Was able to cajole to get 6 packages. Staff, especially Learning Centre staff, are appreciative for having access to them. - Caring Schools Community – not able to procure subs for CSC PD, able to get "stuff" that promote the ideals for Caring Schools to promote circles. Getting \$2500 worth of flexible seating; and may look at using other grant monies to do a refresh on older flexible seating. - PD – speaker (Colleen Ritcey) on Gratitude for wellness SSP goal on Friday; Johanna arranged lunch from Urban Jars for staff lunch that day, SAC funds may be utilized. Other work on Literacy and Math SSP goals, as well as some flex time for teachers to recoup lost prep time in the past two weeks. - Hoping to be able to have non-essential visitors allowed in the building, but current public health measures are still limiting. This may change soon. - Outdoor classroom: picnic tables and stump stools have arrived and been placed in the area at the bottom of the Robie Street berm adjacent the tennis courts.
